We, the undersigned residents of Alwar, respectfully submit this petition backed by 2,340 verified signatures collected on Voetle. We call on Municipal Commissioner, Alwar to take prompt action on the matter set out below.

The stretch between Ambedkar Circle and the bus stand has been broken for eight months. Two-wheelers are skidding in the loose gravel every day and the potholes flood completely in rain. This is the main route to the district hospital — ambulances get stuck here.

Location concerned: Ambedkar Circle to Bus Stand road.

*"I ride this stretch to work every morning. Last week my scooter slid in the gravel right outside the hospital gate and I tore my knee. Something has to change before the rains."*
